<b>Essentials for Progress</b>		<b>Milestone</b>
<b>To Develop Ideas</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Respond to ideas and starting points.</li> <li>• Explore ideas and collect visual information.</li> <li>• Explore different methods and materials as ideas develop.</li> </ul>
<b>To Master Techniques</b>	<b>Drawing</b> <b>George Seuret (pointillism)</b>  <b>Or aboriginal art uses dots</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Draw lines of different sizes and thickness.</li> <li>• Colour (own work) neatly following the lines.</li> <li>• Show pattern and texture by adding dots and lines.</li> <li>• Show different tones by using coloured pencils.</li> </ul>
	<b>Painting</b> <b>Kandinsky</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use thick and thin Brushes</li> <li>• Mix primary colours to make secondary.</li> <li>• Add white to colours to make tints and black to colours to make tones.</li> <li>• Create colour wheels.</li> </ul>

	<p><b>Collage</b> Schwitters</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use a combination of materials that are cut ,torn and glued.</li> <li>• Sort and arrange materials.</li> <li>• Mix materials to create texture.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Sculpture -</b> <b>Moore - clay</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use a combination of shapes.</li> <li>• Include lines and texture.</li> <li>• Use rolled up paper, straws, paper, card and clay as materials.</li> <li>• Use techniques such as rolling, cutting, moulding and carving.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Print -</b> <b>Warhol (repeating image)</b> <b>Or type in repeating pattern prints into google.</b> <b>Tessellations could also be used and related to maths.</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use repeating or overlaying shapes.</li> <li>• Mimic print from the environment (e.g. wallpapers)</li> <li>• Use objects to create prints (e.g. fruit,vegetable or sponges)</li> <li>• Press, roll, rub and stamp to make prints.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Textiles</b> <b>Ellen Jackson - weaving</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use weaving to create a pattern.</li> <li>• Join materials using glue and/or a stitch.</li> <li>• Use plaiting.</li> <li>• Use dip dye techniques.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Digital Media – 2 simple etc</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Use a wide range of tools to create different textures, lines, tones, colours and shapes.</b></li> </ul>
<p><b>To Take inspiration from the Greats</b></p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Describe the work of notable artists, artisans and designers.</b></li> </ul>
